REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS

The Directors beg to submit their Thirty-Eighth Annual Report and Accounts for the year ended 15th May, 1959.

The year's working has resulted in a loss of £7,756. The contributory causes being (a) Decreases in gate receipts and Cup-ties. (b) an excess in the amount of transfer fee money paid as against the amount received, and (c) the substantial sum spent on repairs.

The Club suffered a great loss in the lamentable death of its President and Director, Mr. R. T. Rimmer.

We desire to thank the Committees of the supporting organisations for their continued financial help. We wish also to place on record our sincere appreciation of the services given by the Honorary Auditors, Solicitors and Medical Officers.

The necessity for increased support has been mentioned in statements and reports many times. This necessity is now vital if League football is to be maintained in Southport. With greater distances to travel and with ever increasing costs visiting teams require substantial sums as their share of gate receipts and it is inevitable that Clubs seeking re-election to the Football League will in future be supported only if home attendances justify that support.

The following players have been retained for the 1959-60 season:—J. Richardson, J. Wood, A. Parkinson, G. Rankin, J. Grant, R. Darvell, G. Robinson, J. McDermott and B. Green. Mr. A. W. Fielding appointed Player-Manager in January last continues in that capacity.

Players of experience are required to reach a much higher position in the Football League and we shall increase our playing strength where possible by the acquisition of players who can be obtained within the limits of our resources. Having resigned from membership of the Lancashire League and the Southport & District Amateur League does not mean that Junior players will be overlooked. Every opportunity and encouragement will be given to juniors of promise.

Messrs. C. Hodkinson and J. Church retire by rotation, and being eligible offer themselves for re-election.

The Honorary Auditors, Messrs. Lithgow, Nelson & Co., have intimated their willingness to continue in office.
